**DOES THE ROAD MEET PRELIMINARY REQUIREMENTS?**

- ❖ MUST BE AT LEAST 1000 FEET LONG.
- ❖ MUST HAVE  $\leq 8\%$  GRADE.
- ❖ MUST BE CLASSIFIED RESIDENTIAL (NOT COLLECTOR).
- ❖ MUST BE ENTIRELY MAINTAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY.
- ❖ NO STUDY HAS BEEN PERFORMED IN LAST TWO YEARS.
- ❖ SUBDIVISION MUST BE 80% COMPLETE (IF APPLICABLE).
