

Amendment: Installation of Electronic Voting to Modify Roll Call Process

Amend Subsection (D)(6) of “SECTION III. MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL to provide for electronic voting.

“(D) **Conduct of Meetings** . . .

- (6) **Roll Call Votes** -- Any member may request a roll call vote on any question prior to the vote. When a roll call vote is so ordered, members will be asked to cast their vote electronically. After time is allowed for members to cast their votes, the Chairman shall issue a call for the end of voting and the Clerk will then close the ballot, a tally of the votes will be displayed, and the result announced. The Clerk shall ~~call the roll and~~ enter in the minutes the results of the vote generated from the electronic equipment which shows the names of each member and whether that member voted in favor of the question or against the question ~~it~~. In the event of technical difficulties preventing the use of electronic voting, the Clerk will call the roll, with the Chairman's name called last. The Clerk shall ~~make known the order of roll call votes that will be taken during any meeting of Council by placing a copy of the roll in the agenda package for the coming meeting. The roll will be a rotating list that varies the order in turn before each regular meeting.”~~

Amendment: Delete Chairman’s Vote Order

Delete the last sentence in Subsection (D)(8) of “SECTION III. MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL to remove roll call limitation on Chairman’s vote.

“(D) **Conduct of Meetings** . . .

- (8) **Chairman's Vote** -- The Chairman may vote only once, as all other members, on all matters before Council. ~~The Chairman's name will be called last in a roll call vote.~~
