

The Greenville County Regional WMD Team continues to be a key component of the Critical Incident Response System organized by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED). Our Regional Team is capable of rapidly responding to any location within the state. One of the main components of the Greenville Co. Regional WMD Team is the Hazardous Devices Unit.

The unit is in need of an all-terrain 4x4 vehicle for technician transport. Upgrade Andros F6a robot to F6b and replace batteries on both robots.



**I.C. Describe existing capability levels prior to the use of funds.**

The team is currently prepared to respond and assist statewide if needed, however, there are certain equipment and training needs that the Greenville County Sheriff's Office Hazardous Devices Team would like to have in order to be better prepared to support the Regional WMD team, and the SLED WMD team statewide. Critical needs are related to a limited amount of additional equipment and training for bomb technicians which would greatly enhance our capabilities.

**I.D. Explain the capability gap(s) that this Investment is intended to address.**

Advanced hazardous devices training will enable certified technicians to respond to more complex situations and will give them the necessary skills to handle a greater variety of RSP/hostage situation. 4x4 all terrain transport vehicle is needed to carry tech's and support personnel to remote locations away from the primary response vehicle. Upgrade on robot is needed in order to maintain existing capabilities. Advanced level training for RSP and breaching procedures are needed.
