**MEMORANDUM**

During the Request and Motions portion of the Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, October 1, 2013, I will be making a motion to suspend Council Rule III(D)(9) in order to reconsider the vote taken on August 20, 2013 to adopt Resolution No. 1476 setting the millage levy for the Boiling Springs Fire District.

Should the motion to reconsider pass, I will then move to amend Resolution No. 1476 to allow for a two-year look back period rather than the three-year look back that was submitted by the Boiling Springs Fire District in August.

It has come to the County's attention that Boiling Springs' original calculation for allowable operating millage increase inadvertently included a three-year "look back" and should have included only a two-year "look back". There was an operating millage increase back in 2010, which restricts their "look back" calculation to just two years. The revised Resolution will correctly set the allowable operating millage at an increase in operating millage of two and nine-tenths (2.9) mills.

This memorandum shall serve as compliance with Council Rules III (B) and (D)(9).
