APPLICATION FOR COUNCIL GRANT ASSISTANCE WITH LIFE SAFETY WATER LINE INSTALLATION

Applications will be based on health and life safety issues that include contaminated/non-potable wells, dry wells and fire protection. Greenville County Public Works Department, Engineering Division, will take applications for Council Grant Assistance with Life Safety Water Line Installation. Applications will be reviewed and scored by the Facilities Project Manager, Assistant County Administrator for Public Works, and the Engineering Division for completeness and criteria and will be submitted to Public Works, Planning and Development Committee for consideration on a first come, first serve basis.

This is a 50/50 grant program; therefore, the County of Greenville, upon approval by County Council, will provide 50% and the applicant will provide the other 50% for the installation of the water main and/or fire hydrant down the public road. The applicant has 60 days to secure their portion of the funding and remit to the County of Greenville. The respective property owners are responsible for the tap/meter fee and connection to the dwelling.

Dear Ms. Rosemond:

This refers to your request for an estimate for a water main extension to serve the abovereferenced property.

According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 60 feet along Bessie Road to serve your property. Our extension policy requires that the requesting party finance a portion of the project cost at \$30.00 per foot under our standard Reimbursement Agreement. Accordingly, your portion of the project cost would be 60 feet at \$30.00 per foot for a total of \$1,800.00.

In addition to the cost of the main extension, the requesting party must pay standard connection fees to Greenville Water (see attached "Schedule of Fees and Charges" and "Notice to Our Customers") and all applicable plumbers' fees.

Dear Mrs. Gucker:

I am writing to you asking for your assistance in helping me get some financial assistance with connecting to the Greenville County water system.


For several years I have had problems with my well system. Over the last two years, the water in the well has been at a low level. I am limited to washing only one load of clothes per day. Should I wash two loads it will run the pressure down and this cause the flow of water to stop running into my home. In addition to that problem, I can only take a very quick shower, if I have washed on that particular day to prevent losing pressure from the pump. When it rain, the water becomes muddy, and the hot water smelled very awful. When we had all that rain a few months ago, the well water was so muddy that I could only use it for flushing the toilets. Even now several months later, the water is still tinted. I washed some white clothes and they became so dingy that they looked tan. I had to throw them away. I am buying water for cooking and for drinking. Buying water and having to go to the laundry mat to wash clothes is becoming very costly. Sometimes after I have showered, my body is very itchy. I have poured Clorox into the well, even before I had the water tested, and the problem remains the same. I am truly afraid to use this water for cooking or for drinking.

I have checked into having another well bored, and two quotes were \$7,000.00 and one at \$7,500.00. I do not have this kind of money and I do believe that it would be beneficial to me to tap onto the water System.

I have had my water tested, attached you will find a copy of the report. Mrs. Gucker, please take my request into consideration, and I truly will appreciate it.
