Item (3) Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of PWI Committee on September 17, 2013

ACTION: Councilor Jim Burns moved to approve the September 17, 2013, Public Works and Infrastructure Committee minutes as submitted.

By voice vote the motion carried unanimously by all Council Members present.

Item (4) Proposed Transfer of Surplus Right of Way of the Alley between Bryson St (I0210) and Virginia Avenue (I0209)

Hesha Gamble, County Engineer, explained that the County received a request from the adjacent property owners to transfer the surplus right of way of the alley between Bryson St. and Virginia Ave. to them for use as private property. Mrs. Gamble explained that the right of way was deeded to Greenville County by Deering Milliken, Inc. in 1960 but was never accepted for maintenance by the County.

ACTION: Councilor Jim Burns moved to recommend Council approval to hold a public hearing to transfer the surplus right of way of the alley between Bryson St. & Virginia Ave. to the adjacent property owners, and to recommend approval of an ordinance for 1st reading.

By voice vote the motion carried unanimously by all Council Members present.

Item (4) Proposed 2014 - 2015 Road Paving List

Hesha Gamble, County Engineer, explained to the committee that included in their package was a list of roads proposed for paving to begin in the spring of 2014. Mrs. Gamble responded to questions from the committee members stating that the OCI was determined in 2012 and that the average OCI of the county maintained roads was 68 to 70.

ACTION: Councilor Butch Kirven moved to recommend Council approval of the proposed 2014 – 2015 Road Paving List.

By voice vote the motion carried unanimously by all Council Members present.
