

AN ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE TO THE MILLAGE RATE LEVIED BY THE CAESAR’S HEAD FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Caesar’s Head Fire Service Area is serviced under a contract with the Cedar Mountain Fire Rescue District (“CMFR”) out of Transylvania County, North Carolina, and the CMFR Board has presented a budget and millage request to Greenville County Council providing for expenditures of revenues in the area served by CMFR, including the Caesar’s Head Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the Caesar’s Head Fire Service Area formed in 2004 pursuant to Ordinance No. 3830, annually levies ad valorem property tax millage for contracted fire protection services, and the CMFR Board has requested an increase to the Fire Service Area’s current millage rate for continued operations and maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Millage Rate and Tax Levy. Greenville County Council hereby approves an increase of one and one-tenths (1.1) mills bringing the total millage for operations and maintenance to sixteen (16.0) mills pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §§ 6-1-320(A)(1) and (2) for the Caesar’s Head Fire Service Area, as requested, and represents the three proceeding property tax years as allowed by State law.

The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect taxes in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
