## **PROJECT FOUNDATION - FILOT:**

This is an ordinance authorizing the execution and delivery of a fee agreement between Greenville County and General Electric and GE Gas Turbines, LLC with the application of a Special Source Revenue Credit. This is an ordinance to amend the agreement for the development of a Joint County Industrial Park by and between Greenville County and Pickens County as it related to Project Foundation.
