1.	Please describe any businesses or structures which require special equipment or represent potentially dangerous calls. Hwy 418 is potentially very dangerous due to the types of materials which are transported there at high speeds through populated areas. Ralph Chandler middle school has waste water treatment.
2.	Please list any mutual aid agreements or operational or resource sharing agreements your district participates in with other fire districts. All neighboring fire departments share a mutual aid agreement with Canebrake: Dunklin, Fountain Inn, Greenpond, Simpsonville, and South Greenville. Canebrake also participates in Statewide mutual aid.
3.	Please describe how, if at all, the requested millage increase will impact your district's ISO ratings. This increase will allow Canebrake to repair or replace two aging tankers which are crucial for maintaining the 5 rating, district wide Many homes and businesses are not close enough to a fire hydrant. In addition, we need to replace the aging turnout gear and re-certify air packs and hoses. In addition, we would like to increase the salaries of the paid firemen.
4.	Please describe the tax-exempt properties in your district and the services you provide to these entities. There are two schools, Fork Shoals Elementary and Ralph Chandler Middle School. Canebrake provides fire prevention training fire drills, and community fire programs to these schools as well as to the five Churches in the District.

**Priority 1:** Without the increase, we cannot continue to provide the level of service that we are giving currently. Our ISO ratings could be affected negatively. The need is dire. The district wide rating of 5 could not be maintained, and Canebrake would return to a split rating of 5 / 9 with those homes and businesses far from hydrants being negatively affected. Canebrake will also strive to be excellent in every aspect of fire protection.

**Priority 2**: Without the increase, we cannot purchase needed equipment to improve the level of service we are currently giving. ISO ratings may or may not be improved. This priority level also allows for needed specialty equipment to be acquired.

**Priority 3**: Without the increase, we can continue to provide excellent service to our district, but the increase will allow us to improve our operation in an exemplary way. ISO ratings may potentially be improved.
