AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE GREENVILLE COUNTY STORMWATER ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO NEW DEVELOPMENT AFTER THE COMPLETION OF A TIMBER HARVEST IN ACCORDNACE WITH STATE LAW.

Section 1. Amendment. Division 1, Sec. 8-57(2)(c) of the Greenville County Stormwater Ordinance shall be amended as follows:

Section 8-57. Prohibitions and Exemptions.

2. The following development activities are exempt from the provisions of this Ordinance:

"c. Land disturbing activities undertaken on forestland for the production and harvesting of timber and timber products. For <u>Ss</u>ites that are substantially cleared of trees, pursuant to legitimate forestry activities, no land development applications <u>that would result in a change from forestland to non-forest or non-agricultural use shall be approved accepted for 12 36 months after from the date the clearing is completed, in accordance with S.C. Code Section 48-23-205 (C)(1)(a)."</u>

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
