CALL TO ORDER:

Item (3) Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of PWI Committee on February 3, 2015

MOTION: By Councilor Burns to nominate by acclamation and forward Mr. Johnson (D.17) to fill one of three vacancies on the Parks, Recreation and Tourism Committee. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Item (5) Revised Stormwater Ordinance

Judy Wortkoetter, County Engineer addressed the Committee with a request for approval of the revised Stormwater Ordinance. She stated the revisions which were made were primarily due to matching SCDHEC's 2012 Construction General Permit (CGP) and to provide stronger language to enforce maintenance of stormwater detention facilities.

Ms Wortkoetter answered several questions pertaining to the enforcement of the ordinance and inspections.

MOTION: By Mr. Burns to approved the Revised Stormwater Ordinance and forward to first reading and a Public Hearing. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Item (6) Requests and Motions by Council Members

Chairman Payne asked of his colleagues if there were any items which they would like further information on. He stated he would like to hear more from the landfill on their Enterprise Fund.

Mr. Burns stated stormwater was important in his district. Additionally, he inquired about the Land Development Regulations.

Ms. Gucker stated there has been a committee in place working with individuals from the private sector to update the Land Development Regulations and it will soon be brought to the Committee.
