

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE GREENVILLE COUNTY STORMWATER ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO NEW DEVELOPMENT AFTER THE COMPLETION OF A TIMBER HARVEST IN ACCORDNACE WITH STATE LAW.

Section 1. Amendment. Division 1, Sec. 8-57(2)(c) of the Greenville County Stormwater Ordinance shall be amended as follows:

Section 8-57. Prohibitions and Exemptions.

2. The following development activities are exempt from the provisions of this Ordinance:

“c. Land disturbing activities undertaken on forestland for the production and harvesting of timber and timber products. For Ssites that are substantially cleared of trees, pursuant to legitimate forestry activities, no land development applications that would result in a change from forestland to non-forest or non-agricultural use shall be approved ~~accepted~~ for 12 36 months after from the date the clearing is completed, in accordance with S.C. Code Section 48-23-205 (C)(1)(a).”

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
