AN ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE CANEBRAKE FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Canebrake Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control has presented a budget and millage request to Greenville County Council providing for expenditures of revenues acquired by the Canebrake Fire Service Area pursuant to ad valorem property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Canebrake Fire Service Area is authorized by Ordinance No. 1325, as amended, to annually levy ad valorem property tax millage for operations and maintenance, and the Board of Fire Control has requested an increase to the Fire Service Area's current millage rate for operations and maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Millage Rate and Tax Levy. Greenville County Council approves an ad valorem property tax increase of four-tenths (0.4) mill bringing the total millage for operations and maintenance to twenty and one-tenth (20.1) mills for the Canebrake Fire Service Area, as requested by the Canebrake Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control, which represents a consumer price index and population growth of 2.04% as allowed pursuant to Section 6-1-320(A). Additionally, County Council approves a levy of four and nine-tenths (4.9) mills for the maintenance of a reserve account pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(D).

The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rates authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
