1. Is this a new or existing project? If this is an existing project, how long has it been on-going?

Greenville County has created a new Litter Prevention Program and Coordinator position. Mrs. Deanna Damato will focus on increasing awareness and educating the public on the importance of litter prevention in Greenville County. We are very excited about the new litter prevention program and can't wait to introduce it to the community. The new Litter Prevention Program also includes the Adopt A Road program, the annual County Wide Litter Pick up and the Great American Clean up. Grant funds will provide additional program and event promotion through give a ways to volunteers, teachers, students and community groups.

2. What types of activities are involved in this project?

The Greenville County Litter Prevention Program will distribute anti litter information to volunteers, community groups and schools during presentations and special events. This will raise awareness and help Greenville County citizens to understand how human activity affects the environment.

**3. Will the work be performed by volunteers, paid contractors or both?

Greenville County residents will volunteer for the litter pick ups. (100%).

4. What benefit to the community does this project offer?

Greenville County is a region that attracts an increasing number of professionals and is noted as being a community that is pro-businesses and has a quality of life to support the demands of its growing base of professionals. It also provides a wonderful community in which to raise a family and pursue a variety of educational and career opportunities. However, one particular point of concern is litter, which could place Greenville County at a disadvantage in terms of recruiting businesses in the area. As a result, the Litter Prevention Program partners with Greenville County Environmental Enforcement Officers, local community organizations, PalmettoPride, Keep Greenville County Beautiful and elected officials to stress the importance of litter eradication. Managing waste has become a major challenge and costly endeavor, especially as all governments face budget cutbacks. The Litter Prevention Program will also continue to promote community and volunteer involvement in the litter education program, annual Countywide litter pick up and the Adopt A Road program, thus, creating a sense of ownership and pride among Greenville County citizens. We promote long-term litter eradication that shares the message to reduce, recycle and properly dispose of waste. The grant will assist with the Greenville County Litter Prevention Program litter plan and be very beneficial to Greenville County and its citizens.

5. How many citizens are in your community and approximately how many will benefit from this project?

Greenville County services over 450,000 citizens and the PalmettoPride grant will be very beneficial to all citizens and visitors.




COMMUNITY PRIDE GRANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Upon submission of this proposal, the applicant will be bound by its contents. In the event PalmettoPride accepts this proposal, the applicant will fully comply with the terms and conditions detailed below:
2. The organization will maintain a proper accounting system in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, retain appropriate financial records, and provide supporting documentation of all expenditures. 3. The organization will initiate and complete all work outlined in the project description within the applicable time frame.
4. The organization will carry out the proposal activities in active collaboration with local community organizations.
5. The organization will provide to PalmettoPride an interim and a final report documenting program status and successes and a final financial report outlining expenditures.
6. Amendments to the grants are permitted upon the mutual agreement of PalmettoPride and the grantee organization and will become effective when specified in writing by PalmettoPride.
7. If the applicant does not comply with the terms of this agreement, the applicant may be required to reimburse PalmettoPride for grant funds up to the total grant awarded.


