Applications will be reviewed and scored by the Facilities Project Manager, Assistant County Administrator for Public Works, and the Engineering Division for completeness and criteria and will be submitted to Public Works, Planning and Development Committee for consideration on a first come, first serve basis.

This is a 50/50 grant program; therefore, the County of Greenville, upon approval by County Council, will provide 50% and the applicant will provide the other 50% for the installation of the water main and/or fire hydrant down the public road. The applicant has 60 days to secure their portion of the funding and remit to the County of Greenville. The respective property owners are responsible for the tap/meter fee and connection to the dwelling.

This refers to your request for an estimate for a water main extension to serve the above referenced property.

According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 255 feet along Reedy Acres Dr to serve the property. The applicant is required to advance funds for a water main installation at \$30 per foot under a standard Installation Agreement with the Commission. Accordingly, your project cost would be 255 feet at \$30.00 per foot for a total of \$7,650. Price and policy are subject to change without notice.
