SC JAG – DIGITAL LASER IMAGING SYSTEM:

This is the SC JAG – Digital Laser Imaging System Grant request in the amount of \$101,633. The funds will be used to acquire a digital laser imaging system to be used in the reconstruction and documentation of crime scenes. This grant requires a County match of \$10,163.

Ruth Parris, Budget Manager was present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Ballard moved to approve the JAG – Digital Laser Imaging System Grant request in the amount of \$101,633. The motion carried unanimously.
