2003 - Replaced Engine 4 and Engine 5 and replaced a Battalion Vehicle.

2006 - Remodeled Headquarters Station.

2006 - Lowered ISO rating from a 5 to a 4.

2007 - Replace Engine 2 and add a Heavy Rescue truck

2008 - Added a 3000 gallon Tanker to our fleet. We also upgraded all of our SCBA breathing Air Equipment.

2009 - Built a new Station 3 and added a new Engine

2009 - Lowered ISO rating from a 4 to a 3.

2010 - Added a new Station 7, added two new Chief vehicles and a Battalion vehicle.

2011 - Replaced all Firefighters' Turnout Gear.

2012 - Replaced all radios in all vehicles and hand held, replaced all AED defibrillators on all first response vehicles and add two LifePak monitors

2013 - Hired a Vehicle Mechanic and added a QRV with a Paramedic and EMT to partnership with Greenville County EMS to offer enhanced service to our community.

2014 - Replaced all Firefighters' Turnout Gear, bought a new 79' Ladder Truck, added a new Station 8 and added a second Battalion vehicle.
