- 3. The County of Greenville collects used oil filters at all seven of our Residential Waste and Recycling Centers and the Twin Chimneys Landfill in conjunction with our used oil recycling program. Haz-Mat Environmental provides service to these collection sites. This service includes collection and recycling of the residual oil and filters. (See attached document for site listings).
- 4. The County of Greenville will promote used oil, oil filter, and oil bottle recycling via digital billboard, online and radio advertisements, brochures, Greenville County website, banners placed at the Twin Chimneys Landfill and all Residential Waste and Recycling Centers, Twin Chimney Landfill tours/presentations and classroom presentations. This program will target information related to the environmental importance of recycling used oil and all locations available for recycling.
 - a. The County of Greenville will promote used oil, oil filter, and oil bottle recycling via digital billboard, online and radio advertisements, brochures, Greenville County website, banners placed at the Twin Chimneys Landfill and all Residential Waste and Recycling Centers, Twin Chimney Landfill tours/presentations and classroom presentations. This program will target information related to the environmental importance of recycling used oil and all locations available for recycling.

- b. Greenville County is requesting **\$5,000** to conduct the environmental importance of recycling used oil program.
- 5. a. The County of Greenville operates seven oil collection facilities for residential and small business use. One of these locations collects used oil/gas mixture. Due to contamination, the oil/gas mixture tank is in need of replacement. We would like to install a used oil/gas mixture tank at the Blackberry Valley Residential Waste and Recycling Center, 409 Blackberry Valley Rd. Greenville, 29617. A 500 gallon tank complete with spill pan, high level alarm, spark resistant sink, ground wire, gauge and all vents to meet local and national fire codes, \$9,500.00 plus SC Sales Tax of 6%. \$570.00, plus \$450 installation. Total gas/oil mixture tank cost \$10,520.00. (See attached picture and quote). To provide adequate spill response and environmental compliance, we are requesting the supplies below for use at all seven locations (See attached document for site listings).
 - 1 roll Ultra-Absorbent Adhesive-Backed Floor Mat Oil absorbent mat pads 32" x 100' @ \$205 total
 - Absorbent Mat Pads 15" x 20", 200 @ \$208 total
 - 100 forty pound bags of oil dri @ \$730.00 total.
 - 10 cases of 3"x12' oil socks @ \$74 each case (\$740.00 total)
 - 15 oil spill kits @ \$75 each (\$1,192.50 total)

The total Cost for Equipment and Supplies is \$13,595.00 (total includes added shipping/handling/sales tax.)

- b. The County of Greenville collects used oil filters at all seven of our Residential Waste and Recycling Centers and the Twin Chimneys Landfill in conjunction with our used oil recycling program. (See attached document for site listings). Haz-Mat Environmental previously provided this service to the collection sites at no charge, however due to current market changes, Haz-Mat Environmental is now charging a fee of \$100 per used oil pick up and \$50 per oil filter drum pick up. This service includes collection and recycling of the residual oil and filters. We estimate approximately 14 used motor oil pick-ups annually and approximately 36 used motor oil filters (drums) pick-ups annually. We are requesting **Grant funds for a total request of \$3,200.00 for contractor costs** for the year. Greenville County will pay any additional expenses incurred that exceed grant funding.
