Action Taken by Committee previously:		The Finance Committee last approved a millage increase for the Boiling Springs Fire District in 2013 – Resolution 1482		
Motion Requested Today:		Boiling Springs Fire District requests adoption of a Resolution approving (a) a five-tenths (0.5) mill increase in the District's tax rate from 23.7 to 24.2 which represents CPI and population growth of 2.04% as allowed per Section 6-1-320A of the South Carolina Code of Laws, and (b) an increase in the District's tax rate of one and eight-tenths (1.8) mills for the maintenance of a reserve as allowed per Section 6-1-320D of the South Carolina Code of Laws for a total increase of two and three-tenths (2.3) mills. The District also requests passage of a Resolution calling for a Public Hearing regarding the issuance of not exceeding \$2,100,000 in General Obligation Bonds.

Impact of Action:		A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$200,000 would pay an additional \$18.40 annually due to this millage increase for operations.
