<u>Item (4)</u> <u>Waterline Application – Wild Orchard Road</u>

Paula Gucker, Assistant County Administrator addressed the Committee with a request from David Drummond of 200 Wild Orchard Road. The request is from Mr. Dill's district and Ms. Gucker, Mr. Dill and David Bereskin with Greenville Water have been working together on this request. She stated the project was a waterline extension from 200 Wild Orchard Road to the end of the road at 296. The total cost of the project is \$64,200.00, fifty percent from the citizens and \$32,100.00 from the county. This application is for 2,140 feet along the road. This project is a little different from previous projects; wells are drying up in the area and also large amounts of iron and a wild waterline running through back yards from a subdivision. The property owners and the Water System have met and Ms. Gucker and Mr. Dill have agreed that the Water System will do the work and add an additional \$25.00 a month to the citizens bills for the repayment.

Councilor Burns questioned the cost of the project as it seemed steep.

Ms. Gucker stated the project would include eight (8) households.

MOTION:

By Mr. Burns to approve the waterline application for Wild Orchard Road. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote with one absent (Baldwin).
