

A RESOLUTION

TO DECLARE THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE PROPOSED NEW WASHINGTON HEIGHTS SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT ON OCTOBER 4, 2016.

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Council adopted Resolution No. 1580 directing the Greenville County Election Commission to conduct a special election on the question of whether to create the New Washington Heights Special Tax District (the "District") pursuant to S.C. Code § 4-9-30(5)(a)(i); and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council received certification from the Greenville County Board of Canvassers of the results of the Special Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference, and County Council desires to publish the results of the Special Election pursuant to the requirements of S.C. Code § 4-9-30(5)(a)(i).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL that it is hereby declared that the following question was submitted to the qualified electors of the proposed New Washington Heights Special Tax District, and that the Special Election did result as follows:

- (1) Do you favor the creation of a special tax district, to be called the New Washington Heights Special Tax District, for the purpose of providing street lighting within the proposed district, and do you favor the imposition of a uniform service fee of \$13.00 on all real property located within the boundaries of the proposed district in order to provide sufficient annual revenue to fulfill the purpose for which the district is to be created?
