AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPRORIATION FROM THE E911 SPECIAL REVENUE FUND - FUND BALANCE TO INCREASE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGETED E911 REVENUES THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$375,000) DOLLARS AND TO INCREASE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGETED E911 EXPENDITURES THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$375,000) DOLLARS TO COVER THE COST OF AN UNANTICIPATED PURCHASE OF 9-1-1 CALL REPORTING SOFTWARE AND REPLACEMENT OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Sheriff's E911 Office is charged with the responsibility of maintaining the data base, managing the County E911 system, providing guidance, support and assistance, as needed, to the municipalities, the Sheriff's Office, Greenville County EMS, all County fire districts and other public safety agencies, as may be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the E911 Office incurred an unanticipated purchase of 9-1-1 call reporting software and replacement of computer equipment

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL.

SECTION 1. Authorize Supplemental Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated the sum of three hundred seventy-five thousand (\$375,000) dollars from the E911 Fund Balance to cover the cost of an unanticipated purchase of 9-1-1 call reporting software and replacement of computer equipment.

SECTION 2. Transfer of Funds. The sum of three hundred seventy-five thousand (\$375,000) dollars is hereby transferred from the E911 Special Revenue Fund - Fund Balance to the following account:
