Item Title: Greenville County Museum of Art

Action Taken by Committee previously: The Finance Committee last approved an increase in the ad valorem tax levy for Museum operations in 2008 – Resolution No. 1307.

Motion Requested Today: Greenville County Museum of Art requests a 0.2 mill increase in its tax rate consisting of 0.1 mill which represents the consumer price index and population growth lookback as allowed pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A), and 0.1 mill for the maintenance of a reserve account pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(D).

Staff Recommendation: N/A

Impact of Action: A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$200,000 would pay an additional \$1.60 annually due to this millage increase.
