Item Title: Dunklin Fire District

Action Taken by Committee previously: The Finance Committee denied an increase in the ad valorem tax levy for the Dunklin Fire District in 2011.

Motion Requested Today: The Dunklin Board of Fire Commissioners request a 3.2 mill increase in its tax rate which represents the current consumer price index and population growth millage cap plus the lookback provision for the 3 previous years as allowed pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A).

Impact of Action: A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$200,000 would pay an additional \$25.60 annually due to this millage increase
