CALL TO ORDER:

Chairwoman Seman called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

INVOCATION:

Mr. Meadows provided the invocation.

Item (3) Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of PWI Committee on June 20, 2017

MOTION: By Mr. Ballard to approve the minutes of the June 20, 2017 Committee meeting as presented. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Item (4) Relinquishment of 0.70 acre on Marcus Drive

Hesha Gamble, County Engineer addressed the Committee with a request from the property owner referenced as TMS#0543010101800 to relinquish approximately 0.70 acre or 3,055 square feet of Marcus Drive (J0053) to them for use as private property. Ms. Gamble stated the county accepted Marcus Drive into their road inventory in 1976. Marcus Drive was extended and the extension was accepted into the county inventory in 1981. The first cul-de-sac was not conveyed to the adjacent property owner when the road was extended. Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada seeks to clear up the title defect.

MOTION: By Mr. Payne to accept the relinquishment of 0.70 acre on Marcus Drive. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Item (5) Requests and Motions by Council Members

Mr. Dill asked for an item to be on the agenda for the Committee to consider placing in certain locations at convenience centers where people can bring their tree limbs and a chipper can go around periodically and chip up those limbs. People from the community could then come and get the mulch.

Mr. Meadows stated Mr. Paxton had been before County Council several times speaking about Greater Greenville Sanitation not picking up trash. He stated he had noticed the same in his community and would like to have a representative come and explain what was going on and what we could do to help.

Mr. Dill stated he would like to see the committee having a regular time to meet rather than before the Committee of the Whole.

Chairwoman Seman explained the Committee had already set the meeting times to be the first and third Tuesdays prior to Council meetings.

Ms. Gucker stated next month's meeting will have the Road Paving List and additionally there will be interviews and nominations for Boards and Commissions.

Mr. Meadows asked if someone could come and address the committee regarding Smart Meters.
