

RESOLUTION

TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ENLARGING THE GREATER GREENVILLE SANITATION DISTRICT TO INCLUDE PARIS MOUNTAIN STATE PARK.

WHEREAS, the Greater Greenville Sanitation District (“District”) was created by Act No. 1543 of the 1968 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, and as such is a special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 to which has been committed the function of collecting refuse, garbage and trash within and outside the district, and to engage in the operations of dumps or landfills for the orderly disposal of refuse, garbage and trash within Greenville County; and

WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted to Greenville County Council by the owner of the real property known as Paris Mountain State Park, further described on “Exhibit A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to have said property annexed into and made a part of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing be held for the purpose of determining whether the boundary of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District shall be enlarged to include the property described in the attached “Exhibit A”.
