Describe your understanding of the position for which you are applying:

Greenville's Current Needs: As a commissioner I am concerned with meeting current demands for services related to the health, social, and economic consequences of substance addictions. That means I must educate myself about the nature, causes, impacts, treatments, prevention, and recovery from those addictions. I accomplish that by attending committee and commission meetings, being aware of Phoenix Center's operations and outcomes, attending strategic planning meetings, attending educational seminars and community forums, reading appropriate literature, and actively participating in the recovery community. I understand, and I am happy to continue committing considerable time and energy to all these pursuits.

Greenville's Future Needs: Importantly, as a commissioner I am also concerned with meeting the future service needs of citizens who abuse alcohol and drugs. To plan, fund, and contract for appropriate facilities and services means I must anticipate potential threats that are likely to impact substance abuse in Greenville. One such threat is the opioid epidemic which is causing unprecedented demand for prevention and treatment services in South Carolina. [For example, over the past ten years "there has been a 135% increase in service utilization ... for individuals looking for help with an opiate use disorder." (South Carolina Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services, Opiate Fact Sheet, June 2017).] Another potential threat is the slippery-slope toward legalization of marijuana in this state. I have been learning, and I welcome the opportunity to continue learning about these and other threats that must be factored in to future plans.
