According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 1,130 feet from Mountain View Drive to Caroldean Circle to serve the property. The applicant is required to advance funds for a water main installation at \$30 per foot under a standard Installation Agreement with the Commission. Accordingly, your project cost would be 1,130 feet at \$30.00 per foot for a total of \$33,900.00.

According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 1,810 feet from Blue Ridge Way to Caroldean Circle to serve the property. The applicant is required to advance funds for a water main installation at \$30 per foot under a standard installation Agreement with the Commission.
