a. General Description: A 4/10 mile paved trail that will connect Lakeview Middle school and the surrounding community directly and safely to the GHS Swamp Rabbit Trail

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b. Benefit project will provide the Community: .

Safe Access to the Trail- current routes on West Blue Ridge Drive and Sulphur Springs Road are unsafe with 11,000 to 12,000 cars a day at 45 mph and no bicycle facilities. This is a community with a 33.5% poverty rate and all 575 Lakeview Middle School Students are eligible for free lunch. The trail will provide safe and healthy active transportation options to underserved and poor constituents. It will allow access to the entire GHS SRT Network allowing easy bike trips to the Swamp Rabbit Grocery (1.5 miles) to a community labeled a food desert, Downtown Greenville, Furman and Travelers Rest.


