

**AN ORDINANCE**

**TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED IN THE WOODSIDE MILLS SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT.**

**WHEREAS**, County Council created the Woodside Mills Special Tax District (the “District”) as an Administrative Division of Greenville County pursuant to Ordinance 3684; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose and function of the District is to provide for the health, safety and welfare within the subdivision by funding the cost of street lighting within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, as an Administrative Division of Greenville County, there shall annually be levied ad valorem property tax millage on all real property within the District for the operation and maintenance of the street lighting; and

**WHEREAS**, the District account held by the Greenville County Treasurer’s Office has a deficit balance due to higher utility costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the County may re-establish a new millage rate in order to maintain lighting with the District should utility rates increase.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:**

**SECTION 1. Millage Rate and Tax Levy.** Greenville County Council approves an ad valorem property tax increase of two and four-tenths (2.4) mills pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(F) bringing the millage for operations of maintenance of the District to nine and three-tenths (9.3) mills, and a one-time surcharge ad valorem property tax millage of thirteen and nine-tenths (13.9) mills to cure a deficiency pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(B)(1). The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rates authorized by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
