Item Title:	Boiling Springs Fire District
Action Taken by Committee previously:	The Finance Committee last approved a millage increase for the Boiling Springs Fire District in 2016 – Resolution 1589
Motion Requested Today:	Boiling Springs Fire District requests adoption of a Resolution approving a mill increase in the District's tax rate of one and seven-tenths (1.7) from 25.7 to 27.4 which represents CPI and population growth "lookback" as allowed per Section 6-1-320A of the South Carolina Code of Laws for Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019.

Impact of Action:	A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$180,000 would pay an additional \$12.24 annually due to this millage increase for operations.
