A RESOLUTION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE GREATER GREENVILLE SANITATION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Greater Greenville Sanitation District is a special purpose district located wholly within the County of Greenville;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District are authorized by law to annually levy, for operations and maintenance, ad valorem property tax millage and by resolution have approved and requested an increase to its present millage rate; and

WHEREAS, according to the provisions contained in S.C. Code §§ 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended, special purpose districts totally located within a county, which were in existence prior to March 7, 1973, and which have the statutory authority to annually levy taxes for operations and maintenance, are authorized to increase their respective millage limitations upon the written approval of the governing body of the county in which they are located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Greenville County Council approves an increase of six-tenths (0.6) mills for the Greater Greenville Sanitation District bringing their total operation and maintenance millage to fifteen and four-tenths (15.4) mills, representing a consumer price index and population growth of 3.96% as allowed pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the millage increase authorized by this Resolution and effectuated pursuant to S. C. Code §§ 6-11-271 or 6-11-275, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rates authorized by this Resolution.
