

## Proclamation

On a motion from Councilman Sid Cates Members of Greenville County Council wish to recognize and commemorate August 2019 as

## RELEASED-TIME EDUCATION MONTH

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council recognizes that the free exercise of religion is an important right for public school students in Greenville County; and

**WHEREAS,** Released-Time education is a way for public school students to attend classes in religious instruction during the school day and receive Carnegie unit credits for these classes; and

**WHEREAS**, in *Zorach v. Clauson*, 343 U.S. 306 (1952), the United States Supreme Court upheld the constitutionality of Released-Time programs for religious instruction; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly enacted the "South Carolina Released-Time Credit Act" in 2006 to authorize school districts to award up to two elective Carnegie units for the completion of Released-Time classes in religious instruction; and

**WHEREAS**, participation in Released-Time classes allows students to gain valuable knowledge and broader instruction on religious studies that are not otherwise available in the public school system.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the members of Greenville County Council do hereby proclaim August 2019 as "Released-Time Education Month" in Greenville County.
