WHEREAS, Pastors John and Betty Duncan have shared the gospel in churches, conferences and evangelistic outreaches throughout the southeast and overseas, making ready a people prepared for the Lord, bringing healing, restoration and stability to the family; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Rivers of Life Family Church International is to establish a place where lives are guaranteed to be changed, charged and challenged through the preaching, teaching and demonstration of the Word of God; and

WHEREAS, since its inception, the congregation of the Rivers of Life Family Church International have met in several locations for the sole purpose of reaching individuals and families in their surrounding community through home Bible studies, crusades and tent meetings; and

WHEREAS, the neighborhoods around White Horse Road, Piedmont Manor, Grove Station, Judson Community, West Greenville Apartments, Highland Apartments and Brutontown Community have been served and witnessed to as the church relocated around the county; and
