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**Item Title:** **Sterling Special Tax District Millage Request**

**Action Taken by Committee previously:** Council adopted Ordinance 2214 creating the Sterling Special Tax District which is to provide for the health, safety and welfare within the community by funding the cost of street lighting, control of litter along the public right-of-way, and maintenance of the entrance/exit within the District.

**Motion Requested Today:** Referred back to Finance Committee from the Council floor

**Staff Recommendation:** Approval

**Impact of Action:** Increases millage rate by 16 mills which represents an ad valorem property tax increase of 8.8 mills for operational maintenance of the District and a one-time ad valorem property tax millage of 7.2 mills to cure a deficiency. The millage increase will allow district to cover the cost of operations and lighting.
