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SLATER MARIETTA FIRE DEPARTMENT – MILLAGE INCREASE:

Councilor Meadows moved to hold this item until representatives from Slater Marietta Fire Department could be present. The motion carried unanimously.

STERLING SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT – MILLAGE INCREASE:

Sterling Special Tax District is requesting a millage increase 16 mills which represents an ad valorem property tax increase of 8.8 mills for operational maintenance of the District and a one-time ad valorem property tax millage of 7.2 mills to cure a deficiency. The millage increase will allow district to cover the cost of operations and lighting.

John Hansley, Deputy County Administrator was present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Seman moved to approve the millage increase for the Sterling Special Tax District. The motion carried a vote of 5-1, Councilor Norris was opposed.
