**Re:** Application for Recommendation for Historic Property Designation-  
Cedarhurst, the Joseph McCullough Family Home

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The Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission has been asked by property owner David Walker McCullough, to request historic designation for his ancestral home located in unincorporated Greenville County. The Commission voted to approve the application for recommendation at its April 18, 2019 meeting.

Cedarhurst, located at 11270 Augusta Road, (US Highway 25) was constructed in 1812 and has remained in the McCullough family. It is the oldest documented surviving brick building in Greenville County, and meets County listing criteria.

Therefore, staff is requesting that the Planning and Development Committee forward the request to County Council for consideration to be added to the County's Historic Property Inventory.
