

## PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Greenville County Council during the live-streamed Regular Meeting on October 20, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. (or such time thereafter as other public hearings are concluded) for the purpose of receiving public comments in regards to the Slater-Marietta Fire District operational millage levy for the Tax Year 2020-2021.

The Slater-Marietta Fire District Board of Commissioners has requested that Greenville County Council continue its present millage rate of twenty-five (25.0) mills. The allocation of operating millage and reserve account millage is as follows: for operations and maintenance a millage of fifteen and eight-tenths (15.8) mills, which is above the ten (10.0) mills established by statute for the Slater-Marietta Fire District; and nine and two-tenths (9.2) mills for the maintenance of a reserve account pursuant to S.C. Code Section 6-1-320(D). This represents no increase over last year's millage.
