### **VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCES**

Preservation of 22 acres off Poinsett Highway—in the early 2000's I realized a forest near our home off Poinsett Highway was to be developed. The woods offered natural habitat to native wildlife, a wetland, a natural area for local residents, and a stream with a waterfall. The development would cause the destruction of what was in the mid-1900's a Greenville historic site, a recreation lake and pavilion called Dreamland. I invited a number of local Greenvillians to work to save the land. Our endeavor ended in a settlement of Lowes being built on Poinsett Highway and the preservation of 22 acres, including the wetland, stream, and waterfall adjacent to Lowes. This land now offers wildlife habitat and an urban forest for recreation as well as historic Dreamland property preserved through a Conservation Easement held by Naturaland Trust.
