

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD UPON THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$3,000,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE SLATER-MARIETTA FIRE DISTRICT AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greenville County Council (the “*County Council*”), which is the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina (the “*County*”):

WHEREAS, the County Council is empowered by Title 6, Chapter 11, Article 5 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, (the “*Enabling Act*”) to authorize the governing body of any special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 and located in whole or in part within the County, to issue general obligation bonds of such special purpose district and to provide funds to be used in the furtherance of any power or function committed to such special purpose district and in effect on March 7, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Slater-Marietta Fire District, South Carolina (the “*District*”), a special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 (having been created by Act No. 1170 of the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina for the year 1968, as amended) and located within Greenville County with the function, *inter alia*, of providing fire protection services for the District, has petitioned the County Council to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds of the District in order to raise moneys for (i) the acquisition, construction, installation, furnishing and equipping of a new fire station; (ii) renovations to existing fire stations; and (iii) the acquisition of one or more fire trucks, brush trucks and various items of equipment for the District (collectively, the “*Improvements*”); and payment of issuance costs. The County Council desires to proceed in accordance with the provisions of the Enabling Act with respect to the issuance of such bonds.

SECTION 1 The County Council finds that it may be in the interest of the District to raise moneys for the purposes of providing for the Improvements and paying issuance costs, and in that connection hereby orders a public hearing to be held upon the question of the issuance of not exceeding \$3,000,000 of general obligation bonds of the District.

SECTION 2 A public hearing shall be held on the question of the issuance, pursuant to the favorable results of a referendum, of not exceeding \$3,000,000 of general obligation bonds of the District in the Greenville County Council Chambers located at County Square, 301 University Ridge, Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 1, 2021, and the Notice of such hearing attached hereto as *Exhibit “A”* shall be published once a week for three (3) successive weeks in *The Greenville News*, which is a newspaper of general circulation in the County. The first such publication shall not be less than sixteen (16) days prior to the hearing date.

SECTION 3 The aforesaid hearing shall be conducted publicly at the time and place above stated and both proponents and opponents of the proposed bond issue shall be given a full opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

SECTION 4 Following the above aforesaid public hearing, the County Council shall determine whether and to what extent the proposed bonds should be issued.

SECTION 5 The Chairman of the County Council is hereby authorized and empowered to take all necessary action to provide for the holding of the aforesaid public hearing in accordance with the provisions of the Enabling Act.

EXHIBIT A

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ISSUE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$3,000,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF SLATER-MARIETTA FIRE DISTRICT, SOUTH CAROLINA

The Greenville County Council (the “*County Council*”), which is the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina (the “*County*”), has determined that it may be in the interest of the Slater-Marietta Fire District, South Carolina (the “*District*”) to raise moneys through the issuance of general obligation bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the amount of not exceeding \$3,000,000 for the purpose of defraying the cost of (i) the acquisition, construction, installation, furnishing and equipping of a new fire station; (ii) renovations to existing fire stations; and (iii) the acquisition of one or more fire trucks, brush trucks and various items of equipment for the District (collectively, the “*Improvements*”); and paying issuance costs. The County has ordered a public hearing to be held upon the question of the issuance of such bonds in accordance with the provisions of Title 6, Chapter 11, Article 5 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, (the “*Enabling Act*”).

Accordingly, notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held in the Greenville County Council Chambers, County Square, 301 University Ridge, Greenville, South Carolina, 29601, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 1, 2021, on the question of the issuance, pursuant to the favorable results of a referendum, of not exceeding \$3,000,000 of general obligation bonds of the District, the proceeds of which will be expended to defray the cost of the Improvements and related issuance costs.

For the payment of principal of and interest on such bonds as they respectively mature and for the creation of such sinking fund as may be necessary therefor, the full faith, credit and taxing power of the District shall be irrevocably pledged, and there shall be levied on all taxable property in the District ad valorem taxes sufficient in amount to pay said principal and interest on the bonds.

The District proposes the issuance of such bonds to defray the cost of the Improvements and related issuance costs.

The aforesaid hearing shall be conducted publicly and both proponents and opponents of the proposed action shall be given full opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel. Following the hearing, the County Council shall, by ordinance, make a finding as to whether and to what extent the proposed bonds should be issued and may thereupon authorize the governing body of the District to issue such bonds to the extent it shall be found necessary.

The District is located within Greenville County. The Enabling Act provides that bonds issued thereunder must be authorized by the governing body of the County wherein the District is located.
