Imma Nwobodu, stated that GCRA (Greenville County Redevelopment Authority) was requesting an amendment to the Consolidated and Annual Action Plan as well as approval of the Supplemental Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) COVID Funding. The amount requested was \$1,935,622 for the ESG-CV2 grant and \$2,258,601 for the CDBG-CV3 grant for a total of \$4,194,223. CARES Act monies were the proposed funding source.
