

A RESOLUTION

APPROVING LOCAL HISTORIC DESIGNATION FOR THE JONES MILL LOCATED AT 1210 JONES MILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Jones Mill located at 1210 Jones Mill Road in Fountain Inn, Greenville County, South Carolina, is locally significant to the history and development of Greenville County; and

WHEREAS, the Jones Mill is a rare existing Upstate example of nineteenth century grist mills that were prevalent in agricultural economies of the time; and

WHEREAS, the Jones Mill exemplifies the economic and historic heritage of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission is authorized to make recommendations for historic designation of properties located in the unincorporated area of the County to Greenville County Council; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on November 19, 2020, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission voted to recommend that Jones Mill be added to the Greenville County Historic Register; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission may commemorate this designation by affixing a plaque to the structure noting its placement on the Greenville County Historic Register.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Greenville County Council hereby approves placing Jones Mill on the Greenville County Historic Register.
