

A RESOLUTION

APPROVING LOCAL HISTORIC DESIGNATION FOR THE MILL VILLAGE SUPERINTENDENT HOUSE LOCATED AT 2 MILL STREET IN TAYLORS.

WHEREAS, the Mill Village Superintendent House located at 2 Mill Street in Taylors, Greenville County, South Carolina, is locally significant to the history and development of Greenville County; and

WHEREAS, the Mill Village Superintendent House exemplifies Mill Village architecture; and

WHEREAS, the Mill Village Superintendent House is an integral part of the Southern Bleachery and Printworks which was listed on the National Historic Register on July 25, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission is authorized to make recommendations for historic designation of properties located in the unincorporated area of the County to Greenville County Council; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on November 19, 2020, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission voted to recommend that the Mill Village Superintendent House be added to the Greenville County Historic Register; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission may commemorate this designation by affixing a plaque to the structure noting its placement on the Greenville County Historic Register.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Greenville County Council hereby approves placing the Mill Village Superintendent House on the Greenville County Historic Register.
