Parks and Recreation Development Fund (PARD)

Freetown Community Center Basketball Courts

PARD is a non-competitive, reimbursable grant program for eligible local government entities which provide recreational opportunities within each county. The grant awards are made on a project by project basis approved by Greenville County Legislative Delegation. Eligible project costs will be reimbursed at a rate of 80%. The fund is to be used for permanent improvements to public park and recreation facilities.

Greenville County's annual state apportionment of funding for the 2023 grant cycle is \$81,620.12 and requires \$20,405.03 in local match. The department of Parks, Recreation & Tourism has the local funds designated to match the grant. The proposed project will repair and resurface the existing outdoor basketball courts at Freetown Community Center.
