Item Title: Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area Millage Request

Action Taken by Committee previously: County Council created the Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area in 1988 (Ord. No. 1786) to provide fire protection in the unincorporated area of the County. Council last approved a millage increase for Glassy Mountain Fire in 2015 – Ordinance 4705.

Motion Requested Today: Adoption of an Ordinance approving a millage increase in the District's tax levy of three and five-tenths (3.5) mills from 21.5 to 25.0 which represents CPI and population growth plus a "lookback" of three years as allowed per Section 6-1-320 of the South Carolina Code of Laws.

Staff Recommendation: N/A

Impact of Action: A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$100,000 would pay an additional \$14.00 annually due to this millage increase for operations.
