Salary Range Chart

The Detention Center has one non-supervisory rank (Detention Officer), two supervisory hourly ranks (Corporal and Sergeant), and four salaried exempt ranks. Starting pay is based on your education and experience and annual pay raises for all ranks are based on your years of service up to the maximum salary in the range.

Within each rank, salary increases on a step program based on years of total service until the range maximum is met. Promotions to supervisory positions are based on a competitive testing process.
