
TRAFFIC SIGNAGE

Don't: Install, remove, or deface traffic control signs (stop signs, speed limits, children at play signs, etc.) on public roadways.

Do: Do remember that the unauthorized installation or removal of any traffic control signs is a FELONY.

Do: Call Greenville County sign shop at 467-2628 or 467-2673 to report downed stop signs and other traffic control signs on county roads.

Do: Call SCDOT, not Greenville County, for concerns on major roadways or roads with number codes beginning with the letter 'S'.

Don't: Don't install or request Children At Play signs.

Do: Do remember that these signs are no longer acceptable, in accordance with MUTCD.

Do: Do encourage your children to play in the yard and walk on the sidewalks, not in the streets.

Don't: Don't install illegal multi-way stops or traffic calming measures.

TRAFFIC CALMING

Do: Call the Greenville County Planning Commission at 467-7272 to request speed humps or other traffic calming measures.

BRIDGES

Don't: Throw hedge trimming and debris in streams around bridges.

Do: Develop a compost area.

Do: Be advised that Environmental Control investigates illegal dumping.

Don't: Throw dead animals in streams around bridges.

Do: Contact Enoree Landfill to locate the nearest landfill.

Don't: Remove bridge end markers and throw them in streams.

Do: Remember that the unauthorized removal of any regulatory (county-owned) sign is a FELONY.

CONSTRUCTION SAFETY

Don't: Disregard signs posted in construction areas.

Do: Make eye contact with equipment operator to ensure that (s) he sees you.

Do: Drive slowly and safely near any work crew operation/safety zone.

DRIVEWAYS

Don't: Do not install plastic pipe under driveways within the County right-of-way.

Do: Do use concrete reinforced or corrugated metal pipe under driveways within the County right-of-way

Don't: Build driveways that interfere with drainage inlets.

Do: Contact Encroachment Coordinator to review proposed driveway location.

ROAD MAINTENANCE

Don't: Allow lawn sprinklers to direct water onto road causing pavement deterioration.

Do: Adjust lawn head to direct water towards the lawn/landscaping.

NEW DEVELOPMENT

Don't: Build roads without County's approval.

Do: Consult with land development regulations during design and construction.

Do: Call Greenville County's Subdivision Inspector at (864) 467-7004 with 48 hours notice for schedule on site inspection.

Don't: Change any of the design on the construction plan without written approval from design engineer and County of Greenville

Do: Contact design engineer for any questions concerning construction plan and design.

Do: Call Greenville County's Subdivision Inspector for pre-construction meeting at (864) 467-7004 after clearing stage.

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

Don't: Place or erect any post, fence, or any other structure in the road right of way or do any work in the right of way without permission.

Do: Be aware the County is not responsible for replacement of features should it be necessary to remove them while maintaining the ROW.

Do: Get an encroachment permit before tying in a new driveway or performing any work in the County Road right of way.

Don't: Veer off the road to avoid crossing speed humps.

Do: Obey all traffic calming measures

ROAD CLOSING

Don't: Block/close maintained roads by installing gates, fences, barricades etc.

Do: Contact Greenville County's Engineering/Maintenance Division and request information about the Relinquishment process.

ROAD RESURFACING

Don't: Don't request road resurfacing when only a pothole is present.

Do: Contact the maintenance facility to correct the problem.

Don't: Hesitate to notify the proper authorities of any problems, concerns, or comments regarding road-paving issues.

Do: Be advised that roads targeted for paving will have a notice sign posted.

Don't: Don't place trash and/or yard debris or use lawn sprinklers on the day roads are targeted for paving.

Do: Ensure that no parked vehicles are on shoulder of roads targeted for paving.

Do: Be aware that water on the road surface from lawn sprinkles may delay the paving of that particular road.

SIGHT DISTANCE

Don't: Place signs, trees, plants, mailboxes, etc. that would obscure motorist's view of sight distance.

Do: Plant new trees and bushes out of the County road right of way in order to prevent any obstructions from a driver's line of sight.

STORM DRAINAGE

Don't: Throw your lawn clippings, leaves, or other yard debris on sidewalks, roadways, near streams or any dedicated passage for storm drainage.

Do: Do keep storm water drains open so the flow of water is not impeded.

Do: Do report anyone placing trash, litter, or other debris in ditches or roadsides to Greenville County Environmental Enforcement Division at (864) 467-5207.

Do: Bag tree leaves and contact Greater Greenville Sanitation (242-2361) to inquire about their pick-up of bagged leaves in your area. Contact Enoree Landfill (297-8558) to locate the nearest landfill for tree limb disposal.
