Questions and Answers Issued November 18, 2009

NOTICE TO VENDORS:

The following revisions, additions, and clarifications are hereby made part of the Contract Documents for the above-referenced project and shall be taken into account in the preparation of all proposals and the execution of all work. Responders shall acknowledge receipt of the Questions and Answers in their proposals.

The following questions were submitted for RFP# 15-11/24/09:

Q1) Can non-treated hardwood stakes be used instead of the pretreated stakes?

A1) No

Q2) Can the Tubex tree guard be split to get it around the tree or use something equal?

A2) The Tubex tree guard may be split, however, a refastening method must be utilized to secure the tube once it has been set into place.

Q3) Is the mulch material single ground or double ground hardwood mulch?

A3) Single ground

Q4) Does the one year warranty also cover trees that are vandalized?

A4) Yes

Q5) Can a clause be added for fertilization to include an approved method?

A5) No

Q6) Can water from the creek be used to water the trees?

A6) Yes, provided no damage is done to the stream, bank, or surrounding stabilized area.

Q7) Can a stake be relocated if an obstruction (sewer line, existing tree roots, etc.) is found?

A7) Yes, a stake can be moved within seven feet (7') of the original spot.

Q8) Does the vendor need to submit a map of the trees' locations according to the bar codes?

A8) No, only a listing showing the general locations.

Q9) Can another species' that is shade tolerant be planted underneath the canopies of the larger trees, (Dogwood, Red Bud, etc.)?

A9) No, the site faces due south.
