KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John W. Wooten of the County of Greenville and

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and seventy-five (\$375.00) Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

H.H. and R.E. Norris (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H.H. and R.E. Norris, his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the N.E. side of the Buncombe Road, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot No. 2 on plat made by W.A. Hudson, D.S. and having the following metes, courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at the S.W. corner of Lot No. 1, on said Buncombe road and running; thence N. 59-1/4 E. 225 feet to Williams Street; thence with Williams Street S. 21° 20' E. 70 feet to the corner of lot No. 3; thence with the line of lot No. 3, S. 59-1/4 W. 225 feet to Buncombe Road; thence with the Buncombe road N. 21°20' W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, and bounded on the North by Lot No. 1 and on the South by Lot No. 3, said lot having been conveyed to me by Perry Miller on the 12th, day of August 1908 and recorded in R.M.C. office for said County and State in Volume "ZZZ" page 149 on September 12th, 1908.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
