KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, George Pickett of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-two and 50/100 Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

William Abraham (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said William Abraham, all that piece, parcel and tract of land containing two and one-half acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Gantt Township about six miles Southeast of Greenville Court House on the South side of the White Horse Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone 3X0M in said road and running S. 49 W. 1.98 to an iron 3X0; thence S. 30-1/4 W. 6.77 to a stone 3XN; thence N. 71 E. 4.80 to a stone 3XN in the field; thence N. 52 E. 3.65 to a stone 3XN in White Horse Road; thence N. 37-1/2 W. 4.12 to the beginning corner and bounded North by White Horse Road and East and South by George Picketts land and West by said Abrahams land.
